LYSAGHT - SHAPERS OF COLORBOND® STEEL

COLORBOND® steel is Australian-made pre-painted steel that's supplied to Lysaght in large coils. Lysaght then shapes the COLORBOND® steel (through the process known as rollforming) into our range of roofing and walling products, gutters, fascia and downpipes, fencing systems, plus home improvement products such as verandahs, patios and carports.



ACREAGE STYLE



Acreage design favours simplicity, proportion and connection to the land. These homes feel spacious yet composed, shaped by generous verandahs, extended rooflines and strong horizontal emphasis. LYSAGHT® profiles complement this balance with clean geometry and enduring finishes that sit naturally within open rural settings.

Colour and texture shape the tone. Neutral shades and Matt finishes settle into the landscape, while deeper hues and Metallic effects add definition and movement. When paired with natural materials like timber or stone, steel introduces contrast without distraction, reinforcing the quiet confidence that defines contemporary acreage style.

Attention to detail defines the style. Roofing, walling and guttering should align in profile and colour to keep the form cohesive. Consistent finishes create clean transitions between the home, verandahs and outbuildings, while precise joints and sharp edges maintain clarity. It's architected for scale, simplicity and life on the land.

Select from classic corrugated profiles that echo traditional homesteads, or contemporary standing seams and interlocking panels that bring a refined edge to modern barn and pavilion styles. Horizontal or vertical application shapes the home's rhythm, while matching roof and wall profiles create a unified language across the main dwelling, sheds and outbuildings for a property that feels complete and cohesive.

Tall, slender ribs and broad pans for bold emphasis. Can be tapered to fan across façades.

Wide flat pans with a confident rib for a refined, linear look. Concealed fix for uninterrupted surfaces.

Interlocking panel style steel walling featuring recessed joints.


COMPLETE THE LOOK
