- A mix of materials such as steel, concrete, timber and glass


COMPLETE THE LOOK


Interlocking panel style steel walling featuring recessed joints. A subtly ribbed walling profile ideal where a near-flat appearance is desired.


For a striking contrast, concrete or natural elements such as timber, can be introduced. This balance of industrial and organic textures creates depth while maintaining the style's minimalist integrity.




